Summary of Position: The Powder Production Technician at Stratus Material is directly responsible for facilitating the production and testing of powder battery materials, for implementing and executing a wide range of new processes and systems, and for the general maintenance of production and analytical equipment. This role must exercise attention to detail and rigorous record keeping throughout all daily duties. This role will work closely with material scientists, process engineers and test engineers to develop world class energy storage materials which requires strong verbal and written communication skills.

Responsibilities

- Setting up, operating and monitoring process steps on lab-scale and pilot-scale materials
 processing lines following internal protocols and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).
 This includes equipment like blenders, ovens, sieves, etc.
- Operating analytical equipment and recording results in quality system
- Labeling, organizing and storing samples in accordance with all safety and other requirements to ensure the safety of personnel and integrity of the sample
- Provide regular productivity reports, and incident reports if an accident occurs.
- Know the manufacturing process in great detail and troubleshooting at an appropriate level.
- Keep equipment in good working order by performing regular inspections and cleaning.
- Apply lean manufacturing principles to eliminate efficiency wastes
- In conjunction with engineers, running production and supporting experiments
